Referring to conversation and correspondence had relative to the locomotive you have for disposal, we are now in position to say matters have so shaped themselves that we can make good use of the engine at this point, for switching purposes, and will take it at the price of \$5000.00, delivered at Reno, Nevada, provided of course it is still for sale and also provided you will put netting in the stack and fill the tender with good supply of wood so that it can be "deadheaded" over the S. P. Cos. road. If the netting you are to put in the stack is too fine it might clog and cause considerable trouble in transit which we would like very much to avoid, however, we wish the netting to be sufficiently fine to be effective.

After receiving your reply and ascertaining for certain that the locomotive is still for sale we will take the matter up with Mr. Laws of the Southern Pacific Company relative to getting a crew from them to run it over for us. This may cause some delay but we hope not very much. Kindly let us hear from you at your earliest convenience and oblige.
